

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH LEADERSHIP ACADEMY



The Behavioral Healthcare Leadership Academy is a 6-month development program that prepares graduate level students for management based careers in behavioral healthcare. Students will understand the basics of managed care, business of behavioral healthcare, and cultivate relationships with managed care staff and community executives.

Scholars of the Behavioral Health Leadership Academy will participate in monthly development sessions. They will also have the opportunity to network and develop relationships with local executives.

The Behavioral Health Leadership Academy is made possible through the collaborative efforts of the UNC Charlotte School of Social Work and Cardinal Innovations Healthcare

8 graduate students from various degree programs will be selected to participate.

Participants will receive a \$500 stipend for their participation and a Behavioral Healthcare Leadership Academy certificate from Cardinal Innovations Healthcare.
